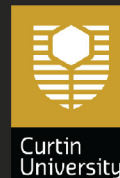


GUEST LECTURE

Overview

In this lecture, Professor Jaya Dantas will provide a global perspective of the COVID-19 pandemic, 18 months after the outbreak of the new virus was detected. Prof Dantas will share examples of global public health responses, and the impacts of COVID-19 on vulnerable populations in both developed and developing countries. As health authorities around the world adjust their COVID-19 responses to the more transmissible Delta variant, Prof Dantas will discuss the latest developments and the impact of vaccines – their development, safety, efficacy and hesitancy of uptake.

Professor Jaya Dantas is Deputy Chair of the Curtin Academic Board, Dean International in the Faculty of Health Sciences and Professor in the Curtin School of Population Health at Curtin University, Western Australia. She has worked for 34 years in India, Kenya, Uganda, Rwanda, Timor Leste and Australia.

An award winning academic, Prof Dantas won an Australian National Award for University Teaching in 2010 and is a Fellow of the Public Health Association of Australia (PHAA). She is President of Australian Graduate Women and has been a delegate to the Commission on the Status of Women (CSW) at the United Nations.

At Curtin University she leads the Faculty of Health Sciences global positioning portfolio in expanding the One Curtin strategy, global demand for health courses, and growing international collaborations. As a teaching and research academic, Prof Dantas is chief investigator on research projects in refugee and migrant health with a focus on Global Public Health, social determinants, mental health and health equity.
