Overview

Professor Parker's fieldwork in various sites in Indonesia has revealed that senior high schools in Indonesia are seriously neglecting the environment. Despite some efforts, e.g. the National Adiwiyata Program and the Eco Schools Program in Surabaya, students are not being well equipped with the knowledge and skills that will be needed to tackle the big environmental problems that loom for Indonesia. In this lecture, Professor Parker will discuss how education can be improved to contribute to creating environmentally responsible citizens in Indonesia.
